Sermon Notes

SERMON DISCUSSION

1. What is racism? Be specific. Talk about attitudes, actions, and systems.
2. Why is it so hard to talk about racial issues, and why do you think there's a divide among Christians about how to address them?
3. Some Christians might say: "There's nothing I should do to address the injustice of _____ because, ultimately, only God changes hearts through the gospel." How would Isaiah 58 respond to that statement?
4. What is "false religion" in Isaiah 58? Why are the people confused in verse 3 ("Why have we fasted, and you see it not?"), and what does that reveal about how religious people can use God (or spiritual disciplines) to feel safe while staying unchanged?
5. Romans 13:8 says we owe love, and Isaiah 58 describes love in public, costly terms. What love do we "owe" believers of other ethnicities in our church?
6. What would it look like for our church to address real injustice without scapegoating, caricaturing, or virtue-signaling?

In the next few weeks, identify someone in our church, family, or home group you disagree with on race, ICE, or immigration. Invite them to talk, and aim to understand their convictions.
