# Sermon Discussion

- Before the sermon, how familiar were you with the passage? Did you change your mind about anything?
- How were you personally challenged or encouraged?
- How might we apply the passage and teaching to our own lives?

## Further Discussion

- Why is it so hard to talk about race? What personal experiences shape your views on race? How have you seen or experienced racism?
- Discuss the sermon and various passages (Ez 9:5-7; Neh 1:4-7; Dan 9:5-6,20; Romans 16:21-23)
- Have you ever confronted a racist? What did you say? Have you ever stayed quiet?
- What is racism? Get really specific. Give examples. Sometimes we get defensive by saying, "I not racist because it was not my intention." Is that a good defense?
- How has our culture tried to solve racism? What shall we think about the anti-racism movement?
- What is a Christian's responsibility toward neighbors impacted by broken systems? Can you think of a system that is broken primarily because of racism?
