## SERMON DISCUSSION

1. You have never talked to a mere mortal. What does it mean to be made in the image of God? In what practical ways should that reshape how we view the unborn, birth parents in crisis, children in foster care, and families in our church—especially when it's messy or costly?
2. Why might James put speech right next to orphans and widows? In our cultural moment, what kinds of words (online, political, theological, "Christian") most commonly undermine the church's witness on life, family, and compassion? What would it look like to "bridle" our words without becoming silent or cowardly?
3. James doesn't say "feel bad for" but "visit...in their affliction." What does real involvement require—time, cost, inconvenience, risk, long-term commitment? What's the difference between charity and presence, and why does Scripture push us toward presence?
4. Read Ephesians 1:4–5 and Romans 8:15–17 and Galatians 4:4–7. How does God's adoption of us reshape the way we view children, family, and the vulnerable? In what ways can adoption/foster care be a lived parable of the gospel?
5. Not everyone is called to adopt, but James calls the whole church to care for the vulnerable. What are multiple faithful pathways a church can take that still "visits" and protects life—supporting foster families, crisis pregnancy resources, kinship care, mentoring, respite care, meals, legal/financial help, friendship, post-adoption support, praying, advocacy with humility? Which 1–2 of these could your group actually commit to this month?
