Sermon Discussion

Talk about the three big questions of abortion from the sermon:

- 1. What is the unborn? When does life begin? Is an infant in the womb a human made in the image of God? (Psalm 139, Psalm 51:5; Is 49:1). Read Exodus 21:22-25 and how the Law delt with the unborn.
- 2. What makes us valuable as human beings? (Genesis 1:27: Jeremiah 1:5. Isaiah 44:24)
- 3. What's our duty in all of this?

Why is it important to not turn away from what is happening? Why should we show people images of what abortion does to a child in the womb?

What are some ways the church can take action to advocate for life? How might we lower abortion? How might we defend these children?

The topic of abortion is often a very personal one. Some in our church were almost aborted. Others have had abortions. How shall we talk about this with one another?

Is our church the kind of community that women could turn to in order to receive help without feeling condemnation or shame? If not, how can you help your church get there?

Questions for those on the fence about abortion:

- What do you think of Jeremiah 1:5 telling us that a person exists even before that person's birth. When does that person deserve rights?
- In America, it is illegal to kill a bald eagle, carrying a
 maximum fine of \$250,000 or two years in prison.
 And the law extends to the eggs of the bald eagle,
 making no differentiation between a living bald
 eagle and a pre-born bald eagle. Why should a bald
 eagle egg have more protection than an unborn
 baby?
- How do you think God is most glorified through the various abortion methods? (Vacuum Aspiration, Abortion poison pill, Dilation & Evacuation)
- If you believe that the baby inside a woman's body is "her body", does she have two hearts, two sets of fingerprints, two blood types, and two sets of DNA for nine months?
