Sermon Notes

SERMON DISCUSSION

1. How have you seen communion practiced in the various places you have worshiped? What is different? What is similar? Why?
2. Read vv. 17–22. What exactly is Paul rebuking—bad theology, bad manners, or something deeper? What does their behavior reveal about what they believed (or didn't believe) about the church and the gospel?
3. Read vv. 23–26. Paul says the Supper “proclaims the Lord's death until he comes.” What are we proclaiming about Jesus?
4. Read vv. 27–29. Paul warns against taking in an “unworthy manner.” What's the difference between unworthy people (which would exclude all of us) and an unworthy manner (which Paul actually targets)?
5. Every denomination in church history until the 1800s taught that baptism should precede communion. What do you think the relationship is between the two?
6. In this letter, the church has the responsibility to judge those “inside” (1 Cor 5:12–13). Matthew 18:15–20 locates “binding/loosing” authority in the gathered church. Many conclude: If the church must guard its fellowship, it should also guard the meal that signifies and reaffirms that fellowship. Discuss the connection to church discipline.
