# Sermon Notes

## SERMON DISCUSSION

1. According to verse 1, why is Paul called an apostle? In what ways should we, as modern believers, take part in a similar calling or mission? How do you see this as an outward and inward calling?
2. Why do you think Paul would connect our hope of eternal life to God's promise before the beginning of time (verse 2)? In what ways should that be a comfort to a believer in trying or chaotic times?
  - a. Knowing that God has appointed a season for what Paul preaches, what does that mean for the believer? With all of this in mind, how do you see the knowledge of the truth directly leading to godliness?
3. Finally, as Paul addresses this letter to Titus, a true son in the faith, who have been some of your "Pauls" (spiritual parents) and your "Tituses" (spiritual children)? In what ways has the Lord used them to lead you to greater godliness and knowledge of Christ?
