Sermon Discussion

Meeting Christ on Patmos Revelation 1:9-20

Looking at verse 9 we see that being in Christ and citizens in His Kingdom is often marked by tribulation and the need for patient endurance. How does this challenge modern ideas of what it means to follow Christ? In what ways does it challenge our concepts of His Kingdom?

Often times the concepts of tribulation and endurance are downplayed in favor of more 'attractive' promises of 'conquering' or 'health and wealth.' How does an unbalanced view negatively impact our understanding of Christianity? What damage or impact can this have on our evangelism or our understanding of following Christ?

Endurance is an ever present theme in the New Testament and is actually demanded of believers. Consider some of the following passages:

Rom. 2:7; 5:3, 4; 8:25; 15:4-5; 2 Cor. 1:6; 6:4; 12:12; Col. 1:11; 1 Thess. 1:3; 2 Thess. 1:4; 3:5; 1 Tim. 6:11; 2 Tim. 3:10; Titus 2:2; Heb. 10:36; 12:1; James 1:3, 4; 5:11; 2 Pet. 1:6.

What is the reason for this emphasis in Scripture on endurance? How have you seen the need for endurance play out in your life?

Verses 17-18 present a powerful moment of worship and adoration as John falls at Jesus' feet as though dead. Encountering Jesus in his glory is a powerful moment. Can we do the same? How do we encounter Jesus' glory? How does encountering Jesus in His glory transform our worship, both personally and corporately? Discuss the role of awe and reverence in our approach to God.
