Sermon Discussion

Text Focus: James 1:5 – “If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all...”

- **Reflection:** Why do we need wisdom to go through suffering? Why does a lack of wisdom make suffering unbearable?
- **Application:** Name a situation where you need God’s wisdom right now.
- **Challenge:** How might your view of God’s generosity (or lack thereof) be affecting your desire to pursue Him for wisdom? Is there an underlying doubt about God’s character that needs to be addressed?

Text Focus: James 1:6 – “But let him ask in faith, with no doubting...”

- **Reflection:** Doubt in this context isn’t mere intellectual questioning; it’s an inner conflict that questions God’s reliability. How would you describe the nature of your own doubts when suffering comes?
- **Application:** Can you recall a time when your doubts led you away from praying or reading Scripture? What brought you back?
- **Challenge:** How might honest confession of doubts and struggles before God and in community open doors for deeper faith?

Text Focus: James 1:6 – “...for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind.”

- **Reflection:** Have you ever felt like a wave tossed around by life’s circumstances – restless, anxious, lacking a fixed point? What usually triggers that?
- **Application:** What spiritual practices or habits ground you more firmly in Christ, so that you’re less swayed by circumstances?
- **Challenge:** Ask yourself: Are there areas where you are allowing cultural or relational pressures to “toss you”? What single step can you take this week to anchor your heart more securely in God’s truth?
