Sermon Discussion

The Deep Secrets of Satan? Revelation 2:18-29

- 1. Imagine being the person delivering the letter to Thyatira. Imagine knowing that you were carrying some very hard and harsh words for a member of that church and those who are following her. What is your internal conversation on the way there? Bring it into your own life: Have you ever had to deliver hard words to another person? Have you ever had to correct a brother or sister in error? How did it go?
- 2. Jesus appears to them in a way that confronts the culture they live in. As an exercise, try to take symbols from our culture that our culture uses to tell their version of reality, and then try to use those symbols to try to explain Jesus to someone who has no background with the Bible. Take something from a Marvel movie or Harry Potter or pop culture, and then, while remaining true to how Scripture speaks of Christ, use those symbols to describe the real story behind all the stories.
- 3. There aren't many Old Testament references as bad as Jezebel's. She's right up there with Sodom and Gomorrah (see 1 Kings 16:31; 21:25). So, how does this reference communicate something about the nature of the issue in Thyatira? Additionally, look at how the consequences for following this Jezebel in Revelation 2:22-23 resonate with the judgments seen elsewhere in Revelation (see Rev 16:19; 19:2).
- 4. In verse 19, Jesus commends this church for things that are wonderful love, faith, service, and patient endurance. And yet, the warning is very strong. Why do you think Jesus is so harsh despite the fact things seem to be going well in many areas of church life? Read verses 22-23 again. Does Jesus still act like this today?
- 5. Considering the rebuke and correction directed at Thyatira, what practical steps can believers take to avoid the pitfalls of tolerating false teaching and immorality within their communities? What does it mean to hold fast (v25)?
