Sermon Notes

SERMON DISCUSSION

1. Paul says Christ died for us "while we were still weak" — not after we cleaned ourselves up. How does that timing change the way you think about what you bring to God? What does it mean to you personally that God's love moved first?
2. Paul says that in baptism we were "buried with Christ" — not just washed, but united with his death and resurrection. As you watched (or experienced) the baptisms, what struck you about that image?
3. Paul says our "old self was crucified with him" so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. Where do you still feel the pull of the old self? What would it look like, practically, to treat that part of yourself as crucified — dead, not just wounded?
