SERMON DISCUSSION

1. What is a missionary? How is their work different/same from a Christian sharing the gospel where they live and work? (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Acts 17:26-27)
2. Think of the long and short-term missionaries you know. How many of them were sent by a church? How many just told people they were going and went? (Acts 13:1-3)
3. What's the difference between a church that has missionaries and a church that sends them in a manner worthy of God? (3 John 5-8; Titus 3:13-14)
4. If your child, grandchild, or closest friend announced they were moving overseas for the sake of the gospel, what emotions surface first? (Matthew 10:37-39; Luke 14:26-27)
5. Is any part of you being pulled to go — short-term, mid-term, or long-term? What's one small step you could take this month to test that pull? (Matthew 9:37-38; Romans 10:13-15)
