

Benediction

Ecclesiastes accurately declares that there is nothing new under the sun. Today's hottest trend tomorrow is forgotten, only to be a recycled two generations later. Such it is with hypocrisy. The church is no stranger to hypocrites. In fact, you might even be able to name some who have been exposed over the years.

- 1. As we think about that what is the impact of those failures on the church? What has been the impact on you?
- 2.It would appear that one of Sardis's greatest accomplishments was fooling people into thinking they were a living, vibrant community. How is a church able to give signs of life when there is none (or little) present? Do you think the members of such churches are aware of the fact that they are truly on life support without outside influence?
- 3. Your clothes can say much about you. Maybe you are fashionable, maybe you are colorblind.

 Revelation 3:4-5 speaks of a few in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes and are thus promised to walk with Jesus in white. Reflect on the imagery of white garments used elsewhere in Revelation (e.g., Revelation 7:9, 7:14). What do these white garments symbolize in the broader context of Revelation, and what does it imply about God's promises and requirements?

Deeper study:

- How will Jesus acknowledge us before the Father and angels?
- Go read Luke 12:8-9; Mathew 10:32-33; 2 Tim 2:12; Revelation 20:11-15. Consider these verses where Jesus talks about acknowledging or denying individuals before His Father.
- How does this shape the way we understand our walk with Christ? How the promise of advocating for us and the warning of denying us reassure us and encourage us to pursue Christ?
