Sermon Notes

SERMON DISCUSSION

1. In 1:16–18, Qoheleth finds that even the pursuit of wisdom is vapor and vexation. Where are you trying to earn security through knowing more, figuring it out, or staying in control? What's one place you'll stop striving this week?
2. In 2:9–10, Qoheleth says he kept nothing from himself — he got it all — and in 2:11 still called it vapor. Jesus asks in Mark 8:36, "What does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul?" What are you currently reaching for, expecting it to deliver what only Christ can give?
3. 2:24–26 calls food, drink, and work gifts "from the hand of God." Name ordinary things that are a gift.
4. In 2:18–23, Qoheleth loses sleep over having to leave his toil to someone who may squander it. Jesus says in Matthew 6:19–21, "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth... but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven." What are you building or holding onto that's costing you emotional energy?
5. Qoheleth could only glimpse joy as gift under the sun (2:24–26). Jesus says in John 15:11, "These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full." What does a life look like for someone living as a receiver of Christ's joy rather than an earner of their own?
