Only A Holy God

Sermon Discussion

1. This is one of the most debated passages in the New Testament. Read the text together. What kind of questions come to mind as you read it? Compare Ephesians 2:8-10 and Romans 4:1-5.
2. “We always live out what we truly believe.” Where, this week, have your reflexes (time use, spending, conversation, relationships) contradicted what you profess? Which competing desire, fear, or idol seems to have been calling the shots?
3. James targets a faith that is sentimental (nice words) and merely creedal (right statements) yet inactive (vv.15-17). Read Gal 5:6; 1 John 3:17; Matt 25:35-40. What one specific need could our group meet in the next month to turn compassion into costly love? What will it cost us?
4. Demons have impeccable theology and even tremble, yet remain rebels. What makes saving faith more than correct belief plus religious emotion? In what areas might we slip into “demonic orthodoxy” — affirming truths about Jesus while withholding allegiance to Jesus?
5. Select one domain — finances, calendar, hospitality, advocacy, workplace integrity — where your stated beliefs currently outrun your visible works. Write down two measurable steps you will take in the next seven days, and name one person who can ask you how it went.
