## SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. In 4:1, Qohelet sees the oppressed weeping with no one to comfort them. Where have you seen that ache this year? How does it change things that Jesus came as the Man of Sorrows who weeps with us (Isa. 53:3; John 11:35)
2. In 4:4-8, Qohelet exposes the motives behind work. He looks at human striving and concludes it's driven by envy of neighbor (v. 4), and then watches the lonely man toiling with no one to share it with, never asking, "For whom am I toiling?" (v. 8). If you're honest, what's actually driving your work, your schedule, your ambitions? What would it look like to ask the skeptic's question out loud this week: for whom am I doing this?
3. In 4:9-12, there seems to be a crack in the skepticism. He's been building a case that life under the sun is vapor, and then suddenly, two are better than one, a threefold cord is not quickly broken. He doesn't explain why this exception exists in his bleak landscape—he just notices it. Where have you seen a skeptic's logic doesn't quite hold because someone showed up? How might you be that person?
4. In chapter 5, Qohelet goes to church. The skeptic—the one who's been brutally honest about oppression, envy, and futility—walks up to the house of God and his counsel is: shut up. Guard your steps. Be slow to speak. Let your words be few. Is this good advice or a rejection of religion? Think about how skeptics talk about religion and pious behavior.
