# Sermon Discussion

*Our words are powerful. How we choose to speak to those with whom we are in relationship is not a matter of little significance: Spouses to each other, parents to children, children to parents, and siblings to each other... We can use our words to tear down or build up.*

God is calling on us to use our words to offer grace. To edify. To encourage. Think about how we see language used in the world around us. Language is used to spark fear, to shape the way we view others. The tongue is so very powerful.

Given that the tongue is so difficult to tame, what are ways that we can influence what comes out of our mouths? How can we build a reservoir of edifying speech, which can then pour forth from our mouths, in order to refresh all those around us?
