# Sermon Discussion

James 4:1-3 says conflicts arise from “desires that battle within us.” How do your deepest desires (for comfort, approval, control, or success) lead you into conflict with others? Reflect on a relational struggle you’ve faced. What were you truly desiring or longing for in that situation?

James 4:4-5 warns that friendship with the world is enmity with God. In what areas of your life do you find yourself tempted to align more closely with the world’s priorities or values rather than God’s? How can you practically guard your heart and mind against this pull?

“God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.” In what areas of your life have you struggled to admit your weakness or ask for help from God or others? How does the gospel uniquely empower humility by assuring you that you are fully known yet fully loved in Christ? Share a specific instance where humbling yourself brought freedom or growth.

James calls us to submit ourselves to God, resist the devil, and draw near to God. What practical steps can you take this week to draw nearer to God, resist temptation, and pursue genuine repentance? How might you support each other?
