SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. The Teacher says wisdom is "far off and very deep" — beyond his reach even after a lifetime of searching. Where in your own life have you hit the limit of what wisdom, experience, or intelligence could solve?
2. Ecclesiastes 8:11 says that when justice is delayed, the human heart is "fully set to do evil." Where do you see that pattern — in culture, in yourself — when consequences are slow or absent? In others? In children?
3. The Teacher watches the wicked buried with honor and the righteous suffering what the wicked deserve (8:10–14), and calls it hevel — vapor, absurd. What do you do emotionally and spiritually when the ledger doesn't balance? What has helped, and what hasn't?
4. Qohelet's whole search ends with an admission: I cannot find it out (8:17). Paul says Christ is the wisdom of God — and that God chose to reveal it through a crucified Savior that the wise of this world dismissed (1 Corinthians 1:18–25). What does it mean for you personally that the deepest things — about God, justice, meaning, and life — are found not by searching harder, but by receiving what God has given in Christ?
