Sermon Discussion

- Before the sermon, how familiar were you with the passage? Did you change your mind about anything?
- How were you personally challenged or encouraged?
- How might we apply the passage and teaching to our own lives?

Further Study & Discussion

Read Verse 4 and then Daniel 12:9 and Deuteronomy 29:29. There are some things that God has not revealed. Daniel sees things and doesn't understand. In 2 Corinthians 12, Paul sees heaven and doesn't want to even talk about it. Contrast Paul's attitude with modern visionaries who want to make a big deal of what they have seen. **Why are we drawn to visions people have outside of Scripture. Why do people monetize their visions?**

Read verses 6-7. The word "mystery" in the New Testament is rich and multifaceted, often referring to truths that were previously hidden but now revealed through Christ. We live in the age when the hidden things are now disclosed. Read Ephesians 3:1-6, Colossians 1:24-27, and Matthew 13:10-17 and **discuss what "mystery" means. If the mystery is to be "finished" at the last judgment, when did it begin? How is this mystery worked out in the life of the church and your life?**
