Further Study & Discussion

In verses 7-12, John gives us a picture of the unseen spiritual realm. Read Ephesians 6:12, “For our struggle is not against flesh and blood ... but against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places”. Christians often ignore the spiritual battle or are overly fixated or fearful of demonic powers.

Talk about what you have seen in this regard. How do these verses guide us to maintain a balanced understanding? See 2 Kings 6:15-17; 1 Peter 5:8-9.
