SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Is there some part of the Bible you've basically decided doesn't apply to you anymore? Maybe a whole book, maybe just a command. Something you've quietly filed under "not for me" or does not apply that truly does. What would it actually look like to stop editing it out and let Jesus have the final say?
2. Think back to the last time you were talking about the Bible with someone who isn't a Christian. It could be a friend, maybe a kid going through something hard. Did you soften it? Leave something out? Hesitate? What does it look like to just say what Jesus said, straight, without apologizing for it?
3. The Pharisees had the rules down and created more rules so as not to break the original ones. But they missed God's heart. So what about you? Where are you doing the "Christian things," but there's nothing underneath it, no actual joy in God?
4. Verse 20 sets the bar somewhere you can't reach on your own, to be more righteous than the most disciplined rule-keepers of the 1st century. That can be crushing. But the gospel tells a different story. Talk about what it actually means to stop white-knuckling your way to "good enough" and just rest in the righteousness Jesus already earned for you.
5. Further study: Jesus surely changes how we read the OT. Take a stab at it: How does he?
