### Sermon Discussion

#### **Further Study & Discussion**

Here we see how prayer works. The "golden bowls of incense" (5:8; cf. 8:3-5), represent the prayers of the saints and the "golden bowls full of the wrath of God," representing God's answer to those prayers. But so much suffering happens between the offering up of the prayers and the answer.

Discuss times when prayer is not answered for a long time. How important it is as we pray to ask God for His perspective - not to mention His patience - in order that we keep on praying and never get discouraged, at all times remembering Jesus' instruction that we "ought to pray and not to lose heart" (Luke 18:1).
