

Questions about the sermon? Text the phrase SermonQuestions to 94000

- You probably know people who have committed adultery. How would you define it? What led up to it?
  What kind of hurt did it cause? Who did it impact?
- Hosea is told to marry someone who will break his heart, just as God's people broke His covenant (Hos. 1:2). Hosea shows that chasing idols is like committing adultery against God (Hos. 2:5). Why is idol worship adultery? What good things in your life are you most tempted to treat like ultimate things—and how does that function like spiritual adultery in your relationship with God?
- God strips Israel of her idols so she can rediscover Him as her true husband (Hos. 2:6-7, 14-15). What "false lovers" or idols promise you life but end up enslaving you? Where have you experienced the disappointment of trusting in something other than God to give you identity, security, or joy? How might God, in mercy, be tearing those things away so you can find your joy in Him alone? (See Jer. 2:12-13)
- Hosea redeems Gomer from her slavery and shame (Hos. 3:1-2), even after her unfaithfulness, just as God redeems us in Christ. How does God's unwavering covenant love free you not only from the guilt of your "adultery" but also from the power of your idols today?
- God doesn't redeem His people to leave them unchanged. He calls them to know Him and walk in faithfulness (Hos. 6:6). In what specific areas of life is God calling you to respond to His redeeming love with renewed faithfulness this week?
