Further Study & Discussion

The plagues are an invitation to repent. They parallel the plagues of Egypt, climaxing in v. 11 with a response of blasphemy rather than repentance. Remember Pharaoh's stubbornness despite being given multiple opportunities to repent (Exodus 7-8). Why are we so stubborn to repent sometimes? Are there people in your life who refuse to repent, even though God has clearly offered them a chance to turn to him? Pray for them.
