The Story of the Bible Luke 24:17-32

- 1.Can you summarize the story of the Bible in a few sentences?
- 2. How does Jesus guide the disciples from doubt to faith within this passage? How can we apply this in our moments of doubt?
- 3. The disciples did not recognize Jesus until the breaking of the bread (v.30-31). What role did the Scriptures play in their eventual recognition of Him? 4. Jesus rebukes the disciples for their unbelief and lack of understanding despite having access to the Scriptures. How should modern-day disciples approach the Old Testament in light of the revelation of Jesus Christ? (See 1 Peter 1:10-12) 5. In verse 27, it says that "beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself." What significance is there in Jesus starting with "Moses and all the Prophets"? Can you cite examples of Messianic prophecies from the Law (Moses) and the Prophets that Jesus fulfilled?

6. Verse 32 described the emotional reaction of having Scripture made clear to them. Have you ever had the type of experience in verse 32? What led to it? Why did you have it?
