WHEN PAUL CAME TO TOWN - GALATIANS 2:1-10

A Timeline of Acts/Galatians

33-34 AD - Acts 9:3-18// Gal. 1:15-16

34-37 AD - Acts 9:19-22// Gal 1:16-18

36/37 AD - Acts 9:26-30

44-47 AD - Acts 11:27-30// Gal. 2:1-10

46-47 AD - Acts 13:4-14:26

48-49 AD - Acts 15:1-29// Gal 2:11-14

1. Read Acts 11:27-30 and Galatians 2:1-10. What are some of the clues that show an overlap. What are the differences?
2. What issue does Paul want to settle and why was it so important (Gal 2:1-2)?
3. J. Gresham Machen wrote that "The central point at issue between Paul and the false teachers concerned merely the order of three steps. Paul said: '1) Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ 2) at that moment you are saved, and 3) immediately you proceed to keep the law of God'. The false teachers said: '1) Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and 2) keep the Law of God the best you can, and then, 3) you are saved.'" Discuss how the false teachers distorted the gospel.
4. Why is Titus with Paul? How does his presence make the theoretical implications of the false teachers very practical?
5. Why did Paul first go privately to the leaders in Jerusalem (2:2)?
6. What is the "truth of the gospel" that is at stake?
7. The false teachers arose from within the church (v4). Does the greatest threat to the church's mission typically come from within or without? How so?
8. Paul and Peter were called to different groups of people. Do you feel drawn to minister to a specific group of people? Who?
9. Why does the meeting end with a plea to "remember the poor"? How does Paul remember the poor Judean churches throughout his missionary career?
