Sermon Discussion Questions

Sewing Fig Leaves Genesis 3

- 1. Talking about sin is hard. Therefore, we often tend to generalize it (we are all sinners) versus talking about specific sins (I did____and it was sin). Why do we do that?
 2. In order to deceive Eve, the serpent
- begins by asking, "Did God actually say...?" (Genesis 3:1). How does this kind of doubt serve as a precursor to desire and sin?
- 3. After the fall, the dynamic between Adam and Eve changes (Genesis 3:7-10). How does sin disrupt our relationships with God and others? (Notice the immediate fallout of this relational destruction; Genesis 4)
 4. Eve perceived the fruit as "pleasing to the eye" and "desirable for gaining wisdom" (Genesis 3:6). How do our own desires sometimes lead us astray? How do they increase relational discord? (See James 1:14-15, 4:1)
- 5. Genesis 3:15 and 3:21 are the first gospel promises. How does the promise about the woman's offspring crushing the serpent's head anticipate the work of Christ? (Revelation 20:2) How does the act of making garments/death of an animal cover Adam and Eve's shame?
