When God Intervenes - Acts 12:1-24

- 1. Why was Herod persecuting the early Christians?
- 2. James is killed, but Peter is broken out of jail by an angel. Certainly, God could have had an angel save James too. Discuss.
- 3. In 12:6, Peter is sleeping. In the midst of hardship are you able to sleep? What keeps you up at night?
- 4. The church is meeting in the house of Mary (John Mark's mom). It seems she had a large house that could fit the entire church. Think through the implications of the wealthy keeping their homes instead of selling them for ministry.
- 5. When things got difficult, the church gathered to pray. How can we better follow their example?
- 6. The people praying call Rhoda a maniac for telling them their prayers have been answered. Have there ever been times you have prayed but were shocked when there came an answer?
- 7. What was the sin of Herod? Does God always judge sin immediately like this (1 Timothy 5:24-25)?
- 8. At the start of the chapter, James is dead, Peter is in prison, and Herod is triumphing. At the end of the chapter, Herod is dead, Peter is free, and the word of God is spreading. Discuss.


