

- Micah waits for "the God of my salvation." In the everyday life, where do you functionally look for rescue — control, comfort, approval, success? How would fixing your gaze on the crucified and risen Christ reframe that moment (Hebrews 12:2; Romans 15:13)?
 Identify one concrete "look up" habit you could practice daily.
