SERMON DISCUSSION

- Micah waits for “the God of my salvation.” In the everyday life, where do you functionally look for rescue — control, comfort, approval, success? How would fixing your gaze on the crucified and risen Christ reframe that moment (Hebrews 12:2; Romans 15:13)? Identify one concrete “look up” habit you could practice daily.
- “I will bear the indignation of the LORD... for I have sinned.” How does the cross free you to confess specifically — no spin, no despair — because there is “no condemnation” in Christ (Romans 8:1; 1 John 1:9)? Name one sin you’ll bring into the light this week and one step of repair or restitution you’ll take (Luke 19:8; James 5:16).
