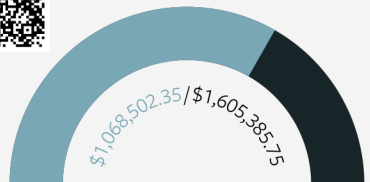
# 2030 Vision
