# Sermon Discussion Questions

Light Has Dawned  
*Isaiah 9:1-7*

---

1. What are your family traditions during the month of December? Are there any traditions you want to implement this year?
2. What is the current spiritual state of God's people in the context of Isaiah 9. Read Isaiah 8:11-22. Knowing that, what does it mean to be in a state of darkness? What is the darkness?
3. Trace the theme of light and darkness as presented in Isaiah 9:1-2 and its fulfillment in the New Testament. See Isaiah 5:20, Matthew 4:12-16; John 1:4-9, 1 John 1:5-7; Revelation 21:23-24.
4. Study each of the titles found in Isaiah 9 and discuss how each one can impact your life. Which one are you most drawn to right now?
  - a. Counselor: John 16:13; Col 2:3
  - b. Mighty God: John 1:1, 14; Hebrews 1:3
  - c. Everlasting Father: John 10:30; Hebrews 13:8
  - d. Prince of Peace: John 14:27; Ephesians 2:14-17
5. All of these promises are for you. Are there any of these promises that you struggle to connect to the real circumstances of your life? Talk to one another about these and pray for each other.
