

Light Has Dawned Isaiah 9:1-7

- 1. What are your family traditions during the month of December? Are there any traditions you want to implement this year?

- 5. All of these promises are for you. Are there any of these promises that you struggle to connect to the real circumstances of your life? Talk to one another about these and pray for each other.
