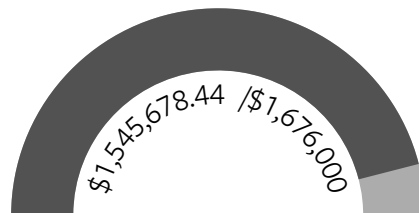

## SERMON DISCUSSION

Few things can be more dangerous than a complacent proximity to the truth. And few other times of the year provide the atmosphere for such danger than Christmas. The stories, the traditions, the obligatory nod to Christ, and the encroachment of secular pressure all mix together to make the holiday a time when one can be so close to the truth and yet so far away.

- How can we as the church rightly proclaim the rule of Christ at this time and not allow proximity to be confused with a prostrate position before the King?
